

PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING AND PRIVACY POLICY

Hub for Change, spolek

We process personal data only when necessary and to the extent necessary for the given purposes. At the same time, we make sure that the data available to us are correct, appropriately protected and not used for any other purposes. We only process personal data for the necessary period of time. This document is primarily used to inform you about the details of the processing and your rights.

Data Controller

Terms and Definitions

Data subject = you

Data subject means an identified or identifiable natural person; an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

Controller = we

As defined in Art. 4 (7) GDPR, controller means the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data. We are the controller of your personal data.

Processor

As defined in Art. 4 (8) GDPR, processor means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes personal data on behalf of the controller as instructed by the controller.

Supervisory authority

In the Czech Republic, supervisory authority means the Office for Personal Data Protection (hereinafter referred to as the "ÚOOÚ").

Job candidate

Job candidate means a person applying for a job in the controller's company and participating in a selection procedure. The selection procedure may end with the selection of a suitable candidate or by termination of the selection procedure.

Customers

For the purposes of this Personal Data Protection Policy, customer means a natural person using the Impact Hub services respectively natural persons representing a legal person using the Impact Hub services.

Experts

Expert, for the purposes of this Personal Data Protection Policy, means a natural person that provides consulting services to Impact Hub customers and those services are facilitated by Impact Hub.

Business partners

Business partner means an entrepreneur or a non-entrepreneur with whom we have entered into any contract, except for persons who qualify as customers. This term includes but is not limited to supplier relationships.

Associated organizations

Associated organization means an entity that works with the Impact Hub on building the member community. That includes specifically the following entities:

We retain the personal data only for the period necessary for the purpose of their processing – see table above. After the expiration of this period, personal data may be retained only for the purposes of the national statistics service, for scientific purposes as well as for archiving purposes.

Recipients of Personal Data and Transfer of Personal Data Outside the European Union

In legitimate cases, we may transfer your personal data to other entities (hereinafter referred to as the “recipients”).

Personal data may be transferred to the following recipients:

- Associated organizations as well as entities with whom the Impact Hub works on building the member community;
- Other members or persons, who are part of the member community, if the member agrees with such transfer, primarily for the purposes of creating business opportunities and contacting suitable business partners;
- Processors, who process your personal data according to our instructions (mainly software providers and IT administrators), and relationships with such processors are regulated by data processing agreements:

 - Accounting firm
 - We transfer our customers’ and suppliers’ personal data for the purposes of keeping tax and accounting records
 - We transfer our employees’ personal data for the purposes of payroll accounting
- Processors who process your personal data according to our instructions:

 - We transfer personal data of all entities mentioned in this policy only for the purposes of archiving

 - We transfer behavioral data on visits to our website for the purposes of improving its functionality
- Public authorities and other entities if required by applicable legislation (including but not limited to financial administration, Police of the Czech Republic and other investigative, prosecuting and adjudicating bodies etc.);
- Other entities in case of emergencies if it is necessary to disclose data to protect life, health, property or another public interest or if it is necessary to protect our rights, property or safety.

Cookies

A “**cookie**” is a short text file containing a specific chain of characters with unique information about your browser. Most browsers are set up to accept cookies. However, you have the possibility to set up your browser to block cookies or to inform you about receipt of cookies. However, without cookies some services or features will not work correctly.

Some websites may contain links to various websites, including but not limited to social media such as Facebook, Twitter, Google+, Youtube, etc. These links are not part of the Impact Hub website. They are part of third party websites that may use cookies that track data subjects' online activities. Third party cookies follow privacy policies of such third parties.

Your Rights as a Data Subject

You have the right to require that we grant you **access to the personal data concerning you** under the conditions set out in Article 15 GDPR.

You have the right to **revoke, at any time, your consent to the processing of personal data** that we process based on your consent under the conditions set out in Article 7 GDPR. You have the right to **object to processing of personal data** concerning you under Article 21 GDPR.

You have the right to request that we **rectify personal data** under the conditions set out in Article 16 GDPR, **limit the processing of personal data** under the conditions set out in Article 18 GDPR or **erase data** under the conditions set out in Article 17 GDPR.

You have the right to **portability of data to another controller** under the conditions set out in Article 20 GDPR.

You have the right **not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling**, under the conditions set out in Article 22 GDPR. When processing personal data, **we do not use automated individual decision-making**, including profiling, i.e. without human interference.

You have the right to **obtain information about any breach of your personal data** under the conditions set out in Article 34 GDPR.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates your obligations laid down in the GDPR, you have the right to **lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority** under the conditions set out in Article 77 GDPR. The Office for Personal Data Protection is the supervisory authority in the Czech Republic.
